Thank you for purchasing Pro Panels. With good care, this system will give you years of service. We have a few tips that will make their use easier.

Unpacking/Setup

- Make sure all levelers are fully screwed in at the bottom before you begin setting up. This will ensure that all edges are parallel when upright.
- Keep two or three panels attached together for a quicker set-up time.
- When setting up, start with a corner to keep the panels from falling over. Simply attach the legs on the top and bottom of adjoining panels using the included strap fasteners (already on the panel legs on the left hand side) and position them how you like. Use Stiffeners/ Support Bars to stabilize.

Transporting

 Panels are best transported on their edge when possible. It will cause less wear and tear. We do not recommend carrying panels on the top of your vehicle, as road grime and weather elements can damage your panels.

Care and cleaning

- Sweeping or vacuuming your panels will get rid of dust. If necessary, you can also use water to hose them down. Water will not damage the panels, but make sure they are fully dried before storing. For stains, you can use an all-purpose cleaner, without bleach.
- If the carpet begins sagging from a drapery hook, you can place the panel
 in sunlight for a few minutes, allowing the carpet to warm, then smooth
 over the area. This will often help diminish any blemishes. Do not leave
 your panels in direct sunlight for an extended period of time, as it may
 cause warping of the foam center.
